

Although WHC serves patients from all areas of the island, community-based efforts focus on the large Native Hawaiian population of Waimānalo. Native Hawaiian or part-Hawaiian residents in this area represent approximately 65% of the population of Waimānalo, which makes this community one of the most concentrated areas of Hawaiians in the state.

Consisting of timeworn trailers retrofitted to provide medical services, existing facilities are inefficiently configured and inadequately sized based on standards for patient care. Costs for repair and maintenance of these facilities continue to escalate, which adversely impacts the delivery of much-needed services.

To accommodate anticipated population growth and development of this area, expanded clinic facilities are necessary.




