Demonstrate willingness to work in cooperation with and support of others.

The 'Ulu Clinic Team Lead routinely identifies and assists in performance and process improvement opportunities and actively participates in these initiatives; promotes and assists in development and deployment of patient satisfaction efforts. QUALIFICATIONS

 Certificate of graduation from an accredited nursing program with preferably a Bachelor's of Science in Nursing (BSN) or an Associate's Degree RN (ADN). Experience in Pediatric Medicine, Scheduling, Administration and Management in a Community Health Care Setting is desired.
